

## 2023 Summer Session Course Descriptions

All summer courses are taught by certified Clearview teachers. Student grade levels indicate the grade/course students <u>will be enrolled in at Clearview Regional High School for the Fall of 2023</u>. All courses meet in person at Clearview unless otherwise noted. Course dates/times, tuition costs (where applicable), and registration forms can be found in the chart on the following page. Students must have their own transportation to participate in the following programs. Payment for summer courses is due no later than Tuesday, May 30. Checks should be made payable to Clearview Regional High School District. <u>College Application Essay Bootcamp</u>: This program is a four-day bootcamp where students will learn the ingredients for a great college application essay and prepare their own. (Grades 9 to 12)

**<u>SAT Reading Comprehension / Writing and Language Prep.</u>**: This course provides test-taking techniques and English Language Arts strategies to improve performance on the English portion of the SAT. (Grades 9 to 12)

**<u>SAT Mathematics Prep:</u>** This course provides test-taking techniques and Math strategies to improve performance on the Math portion of the SAT. (Grades 9 to 12)

**Summer Movie Workshop (Pending Board of Education approval):** In this session, students will work together to write, film, and edit their own short films. The Summer Movie Workshop is a 2-week enrichment program open to all Clearview students, including this year's graduates. It is a great opportunity for students to spend their summer in a fun, creative, and rewarding environment. (Grades 9 to 12)

**Personal Financial Literacy (Virtual, self-paced only)**: The instruction for Personal Financial Literacy will be delivered online through APEX learning for high school credit. This course meets the NJ graduation requirement for Personal Finance Literacy. Regular, self-paced completion of coursework is necessary to achieve satisfactory progress in the course and credits. Students will work at their own pace asynchronously, with Clearview teachers and administrators available to assist during assigned times. (Grades 9 to 12)
