For the foreseeable future, all Board of Education meetings will be held virtually due to COVID-19. Tonight's meeting has been properly advertised by posting notice in the Newspapers of Record and by displaying said notice on our Website and School Bulletin Boards.

Due to Governor Murphy's Executive Order No. 107, implementing social mitigating strategies to combat COVID-19, this meeting will be a virtual meeting. The public can find the agenda on the district website under Board Docs.

A member of the public wishing to speak during a remote meeting shall state their name, address and group affiliation for the record prior to making their comment. Comments will must to adhere to the 3-minute limit for public comment.

Members of the public commenting during a remote meeting shall not act in any manner to disrupt the meeting. If such a member of the public becomes disruptive during the meeting, the individual chairing the meeting shall mute, or direct the muting of, the disruptive member and warn that any continued disruption may result in the member being prevented from speaking during the meeting or be removed from the remote meeting. Disruptive conduct includes, but is not limited to, sustained inappropriate behaviors such as shouting, interruption and use of profanity. Any member who continues to be disruptive after receiving a warning may be muted while other members of the public are allowed to proceed with their comments. If time permits, the disruptive individual shall be allowed so speak after all other members of the public are provided an opportunity to comment. Should the individual remain disruptive, the individual may be muted or kept on mute for the remainder of the remote meeting or removed from the meeting.

Written comments must be received no later than 3:00 p.m. the day of the Board of Education meeting to be read at that meeting and include name, address and group affiliation.
